Are You Prepared to Meet the Lord Jesus Christ?

esus said, "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven; but he who does the will of My Father" (Mat. 7:21). There have always been people who called Jesus 'Lord' but did not do what He says (Luke 6:46). Professing Christians, who do not do what He says, will face Him on judgment day and hear these terrifying words: "I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness" (Mat. 7:22). My heart is greatly burdened for those who have been led to believe they are Christians, but who have never been converted. Our churches are filled with victims of "another gospel" or faulty, man-centered methods of evangelism.

While we still have time, it would be wise to examine ourselves to make sure we are in the faith (2 Cor. 13:5). If anyone is confident that he is Christ's, let him consider this again within himself (2 Cor. 10:7). Let us exhort others to do the same. Our thoughtful response to Jesus and His word will have eternal consequences. Our "response-ability" is God's grace to those who earnestly seek the truth.

To those who are not sure they will enter the Kingdom of heaven...

Believe Jesus as the Truth

How do you know whom to believe? There are many who speak for God. However, you must believe in Him whom God has sent (John 6:29). He sent Jesus to bear witness to the truth. Jesus is the personification of truth and His word is truth (John 14:6; 17:17). There is therefore no higher authority than Christ and His word. Everyone who is of the truth will hear His voice (John 18:37). Do not dishonor Jesus by taking someone else's word

over His. Do not be deceived! Test everything with the Word of God.

Fear Jesus as Your Judge

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge (Prov. 1:7). It is appointed for men to die once and after this comes judgment (Heb. 9:27). He who rejects Jesus and does not receive His sayings, those words will judge him at the last day (John 12:48). He who hears His word and believes Him, has eternal life and does not come into judgment (John 5:24). If we go on sinning willfully after receiving the knowledge of the truth, we can expect a certain terrifying judgment and a consuming fire (Heb. 10:27).

Receive Jesus as Your New Life

To those who receive Him by believing in His name, He gave the right to become children of God, born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God (John 1:12-13). He who has Jesus has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life (1 John 5:12). They remain dead in sin (Eph. 2:5).

Trust Jesus as the Lamb of God

Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29). All of us have sinned and are guilty before God. His holiness and justice demand that all sin be punished by death (Rom. 3:23; 6:23). But as the perfect sacrificial Lamb, Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous (1 Pet. 3:18). The death of Jesus satisfied the demands of God's justice, thereby enabling Him to forgive and save those who trust Him (Romans 3:26). God forgives all their transgressions and no punishment or purging remains (Col. 2:13-14). (see Jesus on page 2)

Only by God's grace and mercy can sinners be saved (<u>Eph. 2:8,9; Titus 3:5</u>). You must cease from trusting anyone or anything else (<u>2 Cor. 3:5</u>).

Obey Jesus as the Son of God

Jesus became the source of eternal salvation to all who obey Him (Heb. 5:8). We know we have come to know Him, if we keep His commandments (1 John 2:3). His first command is "Repent and believe the Gospel" (Mark 1:14). "Repent" means to change your mind when confronted with the truth about God, sin, judgment and salvation. Repentance is characterized by turning from sin and idols to God (<u>1 Thes. 1:9</u>). God declares all men must repent and unless you repent, you will perish (Acts. 17:30; Luke 13:3). Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation (2 Cor. 7:10). "Believe the Gospel" means to trust Jesus and His word and to trust God's promises. He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him (John 3:36). Those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus will pay the penalty of eternal destruction (2 Thes. 1:8-9).

Follow Jesus as the Only Way

Jesus said, "I am the way...no one comes to the Father, but through Me" (John 14:6). Since He is the only one who came from heaven and returned, we must follow Him (John 3:13). Jesus said, "If anyone wishes to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me" (Luke 9:23). There is a [another] way which seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death (Prov. 14:12).

Come to Jesus as the Only Mediator

There is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus (<u>1 Tim.</u> <u>2:5</u>). He is God's perfect man and man's perfect God and the only One who can change a sinner's relationship with God from one of hostility to one of peace. Do not attempt to approach God through any other mediator because no one else is qualified. Pray only to God in the name of His Son.

Confess Jesus as Lord

If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved; for with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he con-Page 2 fesses, resulting in salvation (<u>Rom. 10:9-10</u>).

Embrace Jesus as Your Righteousness

The gift of Christ's righteousness is given only to believers (Rom. 5:17; 1 Cor. 1:30; Heb. 10:14). This righteousness, which comes from God, is on the basis of faith (Phil. 3:9). There is no other way to have a right standing before God. The righteous deeds of an unbeliever are like a filthy garment and must be forsaken (Isa. 64:6).

To those who know they have eternal life...

Proclaim Jesus as the Only Savior

Proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light (<u>1 Pet. 2:9</u>). There is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men, by which we must be saved (<u>Acts 4:12</u>). Jesus is the only one who can forgive us and deliver us from the power and penalty of sin.

Love Jesus as Sovereign God

The Son gives life to whom He wishes (John 5:21). He chose you before the foundation of the world (Eph. 1:4). Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, and mind (Mat. 22:37). This is love, that we walk according to His commandments (2 John 1:6).

Praise Jesus as Your Advocate

Let everyone who names the Lord Jesus abstain from wickedness, but if you do sin, you have an Advocate with the Father (2 Tim. 2:19; 1 John 2:1). God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them (2 Cor. 5:19).

Glorify Jesus as Your Redeemer

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace (Eph. 1:7). You have been bought with a price; therefore glorify God in your body (1 Cor. 6:20). Live by faith in the Son of God, who loved you and gave Himself for you (Gal. 2:20). Do not rob Jesus of His glory by buying or obtaining indulgences to give as a ransom to God (Psalm 49:7-8).

Worship Jesus as Holy God

Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God, the Almighty, who was and who is and who is to come (<u>Rev. 4:8</u>). Present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship (<u>Rom.</u> (See Jesus on page 8)

The Ministry of Proclaiming the Gospel

OUR PURPOSE

OUR STATEMENT OF FAITH

Jesus Christ, fully God and fully man, satisfied the righteous justice of God by paying the complete penalty for sin when He died as man's substitute on Calvary's cross. The Aftermath of The Passion

The Passion of the Christ is expected to top \$400 million at the box office, so we must credit Mel Gibson with a brilliant marketing plan. The movie would never have achieved such great success without Gibson's endorsements from so many evangelical leaders. The endorsements surprised Gibson since the movie is described by Catholic writers as "so distinctly Marian, so obviously Eucharistic, and so quintessentially Catholic." Only time will tell what impact this film will have on the Vatican's goal to unite all of Christendom under the pope.

The Movie Is Ecumenical

Mel Gibson stated the goal of the movie is to shake modern audiences by brashly juxtaposing the "sacrifice of the cross with the sacrifice of the altar, which is the same thing." This is why Gibson's Jesus did not say "It is finished" before giving up His Spirit (John 19:30). Gibson wants the world to know that the sacrifice of Jesus continues on Catholic altars as the Eucharistic Jesus is offered for the sins of the living and the dead. Thus, the sacrifice of the Mass is essential for salvation. Accordingly, Protestants can not enjoy the fullness of salvation until they come home to Rome (Catechism of the Catholic Church, para. 815-816). With his unwavering Catholic faith, Gibson successfully courted the evangelical community to view his graphic depiction of the immolation of Jesus at Calvary and on Catholic altars.

Nearly one million copies of *A Guide to the Passion: 100 Questions About The Passion of The Christ* are now in circulation to help Catholics in their evangelization efforts. Jackie Alnor, in her review of the book, says the book "truly reveals the Roman Catholic methodology for using ecumenical fervor as a way to blur the distinctions between Catholic and Bible-believing Christianity. The film is being used to further Rome's quest to bring all professing Christians under the authority of the Pope and into the waiting arms of the Queen of Heaven."

The Movie Dishonors Jesus Christ

When the Lord Jesus walked the earth, He was divinely perfect in His Person, work, words, character and emotions. To create a visual representation of Jesus, using an imperfect man, is to create another Jesus. Consider the movie's opening scene in the Garden of Gethsemane. We see a fearful Jesus praying, "Hear me Father ... rise up and defend me...save me from the traps they have set." The apostles then say, "What is wrong with Him, He seems afraid"? To portray Jesus as *fearful* is to portray Him as a hypocrite who could not have been perfect in love. His word teaches "perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves punishment, and the one who fears is not perfected in love" (1 John 4:18). Gibson's Jesus is portrayed as a weak, fearful man who draws on the strength of his mother. Yet the Jesus of the Bible was resolutely obedient to His Father and needed no human help in His journey to the cross.

The Movie Exalts Mary

Gibson said, "I've been amazed at the way the evangelical audience has...responded to this film" because "the film is so Marian." The film's exaltation of Mary comes from the visions of a 19th century Catholic mystic, Sister Anne Catherine Emmerich. Her visions are revealed in her book, *The Dolorous Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ*, which is dedicated "to the Immaculate Heart of the Virgin Mary, Mother of God, Queen of Heaven and Earth, Lady of the Most Holy Rosary, Help of Christians, and Refuge of the Human Race." According to Emmerich, Our Lady is often called our "<u>Co-Redemptrix</u>" because of her participation in the sufferings of her Son.

Let us all cry for discernment in these days of great deception and apostasy!

Capitulation and Compromise Continue



The Passion - Catholic Movie

In The Passion of the Christ, Mel Gibson places the Virgin Mother of God in what is obviously the closest personal contact with the sufferings of her Son. She, who is Mother of the Redeemer, becomes by that fact mother of all who are redeemed. Gibson captures what the Pope writes in "Mother of the Redeemer" in a way that alone merits the film the title "Catholic." Gibson portrays Mary by placing "herself between her Son and mankind in the reality of their wants, needs and sufferings [remember Peter at her feet]. She puts herself 'in the middle,' that is to say she acts as a mediatrix not as an outsider, but in her position as mother." If we recognize that the Passion is related to the Church, then we also recognize that it is related to the reality of the Eucharistic conversion. There is a sense in which the whole film is about the Eucharist - The Bread of Life. The movie invites its viewers to recognize that in the eucharistized bread the joyful Jim Caviezel offers to his priest-disciples we discover the one source of the love that never ends. Vatican for European Unity

The re-establishment of Christian unity is urgent for Europe, a Vatican official said in Moscow's Catholic Cathedral of Mary Immaculate. Cardinal Walter Kasper, the president of the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity, delivered that message in the Russian capital. Addressing the Catholic bishops and about 100 other people, Kasper said: "In our time, the Holy Spirit has inspired repentance and shame" for the disunity between the Church of the East and the West "and has started the ecumenical movement." "Catholics and Orthodox pray the same 'Our Father" and yet, they have been separated for many centuries," a separation that is "contrary to the will of Jesus"

and "a scandal to the eyes of the world," he said. The rapprochement between separated Christians is one of the priorities of the Pope, who prays and works tirelessly for Christian unity. The cardinal stressed that "the re-establishment of unity today is urgent also for the unity of Europe," because "Europe is not only an economic unity of well-being, it is a cultural unity." "Europe needs a soul, a Christian soul, so the unity of Europe also makes urgent the unity of the Church." (Zenit.org., 2/18/04)

Mankind Entrusted to Mary

John Paul II recalled three moments in his pontificate when he entrusted the Church, the world and mankind to Mary: December 8, 1978; June 4, 1979, renewing this vow at the shrine of the Black Madonna in Poland and 1984. "I remember especially March 25, 1984, the Holy Year. Twenty years have gone by since that day when in spiritual union with all the bishops of the world I entrusted all of mankind to the Immaculate Heart of Mary in response to Our Lady's plea in Fatima." Catholic Priests Are a Gift from God

The pope made an appeal to pray to the "Father of the Mass" and to bear witness to young people about the greatness and beauty of priestly vocations in his Letter to Priests. The pope recalled the Last Supper, when Jesus instituted the Eucharistic liturgy and the priesthood before dying. He says this marked the first time men were called to the priesthood. The pope stressed that "the Eucharist like the Priesthood" is a "gift from God." In the letter the pope wrote: "We were born from the Eucharist. If we can truly say that the whole Church lives from the Eucharist, we can say the same thing about the ministerial priesthood: it is born, lives, works and bears fruit. There can be no Eucharist without the priesthood, just as there can be no priesthood without the Eucharist" The ordained ministry...enables the priest to act "in persona Christi" and culminates in the moment when he consecrates the bread and wine. The letter's last thoughts are turned to Mary, "the Mother of priests." The pope asks her to protect ministers from making "the mystery placed in your hands" a routine habit. (Zenit.org, 4/6/04)

Holy Relics on Display

Thousands of people flocked to see relics associated with Christ's death, in a rare display over the weekend at a Cathedral in St. Louis, Mo. Several of the long-venerated relics, from pieces of the cross, to replicas of the nails believed to have been used 2,000 years ago to crucify Christ, are now on public display. The event was organized by the Apostolate for Holy Relics, a Los Angelesbased nonprofit that last year drew more than 140,000 people to displays of a 16th-century relic of St. Juan Diego. Andrew Walther, vice president of the Apostolate for Holy Relics, said: "We hope that people will come away from viewing these relics with an increased faith and personal connection to Christ's loving sacrifice." Mobile Confessionals

The sacrament of reconciliation is going mobile. A German Catholic charity hopes to rekindle enthusiasm for the sacrament of penance by means of a van outfitted as a "mobile confessional." The van will be presented, blessed and sent out during the charity's international congress in Augsburg. The confessional on wheels will be used during events such as World Youth Day 2005 in Cologne. It will also offer people the chance to speak to a priest and to get spiritual counseling during its journey throughout the country. (Zenit.org, 2/29/04)

Rosary Unites Europe

Capitals of the 10 countries that will soon enter the European Union will participate when John Paul II leads the praying of a rosary on European University Day. The climax of the day -- a Marian vigil with the Pope in Paul VI Hall will be broadcast via satellite to the 10 capitals. The director of the Office for University Pastoral Care, mentioned last year's rosary with the Pope and said: "None of us can forget the enthusiasm and emotion of the link with Moscow, which ensured a sort of 'virtual visit' of John Paul II to the 'third Rome.''' 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
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

<u>12:1</u>). Do not worship Jesus in vain by following the traditions of men (Mark 7:7). Do not become futile in your speculations by exchanging the glory of the incorruptible God for an image (Rom. 1:23).

Honor Jesus as your only Priest

As a merciful and faithful high priest, He satisfied divine justice by offering Himself once for all sin for all time (Heb. 2:17; 10:12). At that moment God tore open the veil to the holy of holies (Mat. 27:51). Repentant sinners now have access to the Father through faith in His shed blood (Eph. 2:18). Since there are no more offerings for sin, do not dishonor Jesus by participating in ongoing offerings by other priests (Heb. 10:18). For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified (Heb. 10:14).

Serve Jesus as Your Master

No one can serve two masters. Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will hold to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon (<u>Mat. 6:24</u>). Since we receive a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us show gratitude, by offering to God an acceptable service with rever-

ence and awe (<u>Heb. 12:28</u>). Jesus said, "If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there shall My servant also be; if anyone serves Me, the Father will honor him" (John 12:26).

Long for Jesus as your Blessed Hope

Look for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus (<u>Titus 2:13</u>). What a glorious day that will be for all who have responded with faith and obedience to the Lord Jesus!
